



NG Road Racing Thruxton 22nd 23rd August 2026 Statement

On Sunday 23rd August 2026 during race 25 the Lansdowne Classic championship there was an incident resulting in a rider falling from his machine at the Village / Church Corner section of the circuit. The race was immediately stopped and a lengthy trackside medical intervention followed. The rider was later transferred to the circuit medical centre and then onto Hospital in Southampton via air ambulance.

While the race schedule was able to continue, a further serious incident occurred during Race 27 the 250GP ACU National Championship, where a rider also received a lengthy trackside medical intervention. This rider was also transferred to the circuit medical centre and later to Hospital in Southampton for further treatment.

The combination of these two medical interventions resulted in the unfortunate abandonment of the event due to there being a strict 18:30 noise curfew at Thruxton Circuit.

We are pleased to report that the 250GP National rider #20 Gavin Mills, was released from hospital the same night and is now recovering at home.

The Lansdowne Classic rider #49 Richard Hann, remains in hospital under observation and receiving treatment for his injuries.

The NG Road Racing family extend their best wishes to Richard and Gavin for their speedy and full recoveries.

Due to the tight schedules at the remaining 2 events, there will not be an opportunity to reschedule the abandoned races. We appreciate this is very disappointing for those riders affected and would like to thank you for your concern and understanding.
