



WIRRAL 100 CHAMPIONSHIPS FOR 2026 – REGISTRATION.

Background

In order to register for the Wirral 100 ('W100') Championship series to be run as part of the NG Road Racing Club's events in 2026 at Cadwell Park, Anglesey, Donington Park & Oulton Park, riders must be members of W100 and must now additionally register on NG's website (<https://www.ngroadracing.co.uk/>) to ensure that they receive all relevant information (including Newsletters) for when the events 'go live'.

As a reminder the Championship rounds (including Friday test days) are as follows:

Cadwell Park	17 th to 19 th April (3 races)
Anglesey	8 th to 10 th May (3 races)
Donington Park	11 th to 13 th September (3 races)
Oulton Park	9 th & 10 th October (2 races)

The W100 Championship classes (identical to those applicable for NG) are now confirmed as follows:

Powerbikes	Sportbike / Supertwins
National 600	Open 500
Clubman 600	

Trophies & Awards

- For each meeting, trophies will be awarded to the first three finishers on aggregate of all three races for the weekend (2 for Oulton Park).
- In addition, championship trophies will be awarded to the first 3 finishers on aggregate across the season. Points per race will be awarded as follows: 1st – 10 points, 2nd – 8 pts, 3rd – 6 pts, 4th – 5 pts, 5th – 4 pts, 6th – 3pts, 7th – 2 pts, 8th – 1 pt. Double points will be awarded for the final meeting of the year at Oulton Park; a presentation evening will then follow the racing on 10th October.

Eligibility

To be eligible to compete in the W100 Championships, riders must be registered as a W100 member for 2026. The annual subscription remains at just £25. Please note that 84 persons paid subscriptions in January, February & March 2025 and were accordingly registered as members for 2025; as there were no racing activities in 2025, the Club's committee has agreed to carry forward those 84 subscriptions to 2026. Additional riders now wishing to join the Club for 2026 and compete in the W100 Championships should do so, via – forms.gle/2n2iRtHADs2CyGF6.
