



NG Road Racing Final Instructions and Information for CASTLE COMBE – Test Day Saturday 7th March 2026



- **Introduction:** Motor Cycle Test Day to be held at Castle Combe Circuit, Chippenham, Wiltshire. SN14 7EY. ACU Temporary Course License number **TCL 014**. ACU Test Event Permit Number **ACU 206922 EMN10/2189**
- **Access to the Circuit:** From 1700hrs Friday 6th March. Please do not arrive before this time. There will be ample space as the entry is restricted to 75 participants. **The gate will be locked at 2200hrs sharp**, and will reopen on Saturday at 0700hrs. Please do not arrive at the venue after 2200hrs on Friday and before 0700hrs Saturday as there is nowhere to park or “stack” outside the circuit. Please arrive and leave the venue quietly in consideration of local residents.
- **Passes:** Will not be issued for this event.
- **Leaving the Venue:** Please ensure you leave the venue by 1800hrs Saturday evening.
- **Facilities:** Toilets and showers will be open as usual. Food and drink is available from the Paddock Diner throughout Saturday only.
- **Technical Inspection:** It is the responsibility of the test day entrant to ensure his/her machine and ALL race clothing and helmet is track worthy and prepared in accordance with the Auto Cycle Union Standing Regulations found on-line at www.ACU.org.uk within the information library each and every time he/she joins the circuit. **ACU Gold crash helmet stickers are not available to purchase at the venue however your crash helmet must have the correct gold sticker applied.**
- **Sound Testing:** Will commence from 0730 adjacent to the technical inspection bay. All machines must be sound tested before going on circuit. The maximum noise level is 105dBA
- **Race Administration:** Opens 0700hrs Saturday 7th March in the Strawford Centre.
- **Riders Briefing:** There will be a riders briefing at 0830hrs in the garage adjacent to Race Administration. Attendance is mandatory.
- **Format:** Testing from 0900hrs in 5 x groups of 15 riders. You will be notified of your group number at signing on. The event finishes at 1715hrs. The lunch break will be extended to accommodate ACU license trainees on-track assessments or “Basic Rider Assessments”. We thank you in advance for your patience.
- **UK Junior Series riders** shall have their own session from 1700 to 1715. Call Race Admin today.
- **Paddock Support Services:** Our paddock support services DCM will be present at this event. Please contact Dan Cooper Motorsport on dancoopermotorsport@gmail.com or call 07423 254257 to pre order your tyres.
- **Fit to Ride Process:** Our Fit to Ride process remains live for this event. If you fall from your machine, regardless of speed and/or circumstances, **you are immediately classed as unfit**. You are unable to continue testing, until such time you have been declared fit in writing by the CMO then, visited The Race Admin Centre for further instructions. Our Fit to Ride process has been updated to include a **Head Injury Assessment** in the event of there being **any** evidence of damage or impact to a rider’s crash helmet.

PADDOCK RULES

- You must not hammer or insert pegs into the tarmac. Fuel must be stored in a suitable, fit for purpose container. Each team must be equipped with an approved, in-date fire extinguisher, random checking will take place. Report any spillages to the Race Office immediately.
- Tyres, batteries, contaminated fuel and oil containers are classed as hazardous waste. You **MUST** take them home with you. The club are charged per item left in the paddock.
- The riding of **motorised bikes, or scooters including E Scooters anywhere at this venue is forbidden**. If anyone is caught riding these, you and/or your team will be excluded from the event.
- Push bikes are permitted however, please do not use them in or around the paddock while the track is live.
- Children are welcome however, they must be accompanied by an adult at all time.
- Generators: There is a 2300 hrs curfew on running generators and all noise in the paddock. Please respect others. Competitors are responsible for the conduct of their family and team members.
