



Final Instructions and Event Information for Donington Park TEST DAY Friday 15th August 2025

Held under the National Sporting Code of the Auto Cycle Union Permit Number ACU 205130



These instructions are to be read in addition to the information provided below for the race event. It is a condition of entry that these instructions are read and accepted.

- Access to the Venue: ALL areas and pre booked garages from 18:00 hrs Thursday 14th August.
 - It is essential you do not arrive before this time. Early arrivals will be stacked in an area off site.
- Noise Testing / On-track noise monitoring: As a week-day event, the test day will operate a "ride-by" testing process throughout the entire day. The maximum permitted sound level is 98dBA ride-by. Any rider exceeding this at any time throughout the day will be black flagged. If you are black flagged, you must leave the circuit immediately via the pit lane. Once black flagged, riders will have one further chance to reduce the noise level of their machine so it falls within the permitted level. Any rider black flagged a 2nd time, will be excluded from the day. We are unable to offer refunds to riders who fail the noise monitoring process. NO RACE ENGINES NOR PADDOCK PA BEFORE 09:00
- Race Administration Centre / Friday Signing On: Opens Friday from 07:00 to 19:00. Saturday 07:00 until 30 minutes after the final race. Sunday from 07:00 until 30 minutes after the final race. Race Administration can be found on the first floor above the garages. Please bring your licence QR code to be scanned ensuring it is current, with no outstanding actions. Please collect your Entry Declaration / Technical Inspection Form for Saturday/Sunday after 09:30 Friday.
- <u>Technical Inspection:</u> There is no formal Technical Inspection for Friday Testing. It is a condition of entry and solely the responsibility of the rider to ensure his/her machine is prepared in accordance with the ACU Standing regulations for Road Race prior to joining the circuit EACH TIME. You must clearly display your race number for testing.
- <u>Test Sessions:</u> 4 groups will run throughout the day commencing at **09:10**, finishing at 17:00, with one hour break for lunch at 12:30. Times may be subject to change.
- <u>Leaving the Circuit</u>: **TEST DAY ONLY**. Once you have passed the chequered flag, you will complete one full slowing down lap and enter the pit lane. (Saturday and Sunday you will leave the circuit at turn 1, Redgate Corner)
- <u>Practice Starts</u>: Will be permitted as follows: After you have passed the chequered flag at the end of
 the session, during the afternoon test sessions only. The practice start area is on the right hand
 side 50 meters after Coppice Corner as you enter the back straight strictly off the racing
 line against the grass on the inside of the circuit. A board will be positioned at this location during
 the lunch period stating "Practice Start Zone" You must not carry out practice starts at any other
 time or at any other location around the track.
- <u>Security:</u> Please ensure you lock away possessions and valuables while you are on-track and overnight. We politely ask all teams, family members and friends to be particularly vigilant at this venue.
- Marshals and Officials Signing On: Will take place in the from 07:00hrs each day in "Garage 39"
- Refund / Cancellation Policy: If less than 2 weeks prior to 09:00am day 1 of the event, a rider has a genuine reason for not being able to attend the event, he/she must inform Race Administration in writing and any passes issued must be returned immediately. Once the passes are returned, a refund will be arranged less an administration charge of £50.00. If a rider cancels within 7 days of day 1 of the event i.e. the Friday test day, a 50% refund of all fees paid will be given. Withdrawal once the event has started i.e. 09:00 Friday morning: Once testing has commenced on Friday morning, no refunds for the weekend will be given. NG Road Racing reserve the right to review refunds on a case by case basis.
 - This policy also covers riders who, via prior agreement only have permission to "pay on the day"
- Falling From Your Machine Friday Test Day: The "Fit to Ride" process remains live for Friday test days. Should you fall from your machine, you must ensure your "Fit to Ride" card is signed off by a Medical Officer at the Medical Centre before you go back on circuit. As per Test Day Technical Inspection, you/the rider remains solely responsible for the race-worthiness of your machine.


- Facilities: All facilities will be open for business. A limited amount of electric points are available across Paddock 2 however, this does not cover the entirety of Paddock 2 and 3. Electric Vehicles must not be charged using general power outlets around the paddock. Please see the "Fair Usage Policy" to ensure we retain the use of power at these venues in the future. There is a significant additional cost to the club for the electric to be connected. A donation in Race Administration would be greatly appreciated.
- Race Administration Centre: Opens Friday from 07:00 to 19:00. Saturday 07:00 until 30 minutes after the final race. Sunday from 07:00 until 30 minutes after the final race. Race Administration can be found on the first floor above the garages. Please collect your Signing on / Technical Inspection form from Race Administration during Friday and before you go through Technical Inspection Friday evening...
- Garages: Are available via advance booking only. The charge for the weekend is £30 per rider which must be paid at signing on, Friday morning in the Race Administration Centre. It is essential that only pre booked entrants occupy the garages. Please remember you may be sharing your garage with other teams, therefore you must not invite your friends in who have not booked. You must have an accepted entry for all 3 days to book a garage. There is strictly no access to the race track through the front of the garages.
- **Technical Inspection**: Technical Inspection opens from 16:00 Friday evening, 07:00 Saturday. Please bring your SIGNED Signing on / Technical Inspection form with you to Technical Inspection, as an official will need to sign it once you have passed. You then return the form to Race Admin to complete the signing on process.
- Noise / Sound Testing: The testing process is via ride-by only. The maximum limit is 105dBA as per current ACU Technical Regulations. No race engines are to be run before 09:00 Saturday & Sunday including "warming them up" There will also be NO PA announcements before 09:00
- Assembly Area: It is your responsibility to be in the assembly area in good time prior to your practice session or race. We will start without you! You must join the circuit only via the assembly area. The assembly area can be found to rear of garages 1 & 2 / Race Control tower.
- Event format: Saturday 09:10: Free practice all machines, Qualifying all classes, 1 Championship race. Sunday 09:10: Warm up (if required) 2 Championship races all classes. Please note the start times: This is due to the "no engines to be run before 09:00" rule.
- Blue Flags: Will only be used for the 125GP and 250GP ACU National Championship sessions and races
- Transponders / Timing: Timing is by TSL. Hire Transponders can be collected from Race Administration from 07:00am Saturday morning. Please return hire transponders immediately after your final race of the weekend. Further information from Raceadmin@ngroadracing.co.uk You will lose your £30 deposit if you take your hire transponder home with you. Please contact Race Admin ASAP to arrange getting it returned. We can not accept it being returned at the following round.
- Falling from your machine: We operate a strict "fit to ride" policy. Should you fall from your machine, regardless of the speed and circumstances, you are entered onto the "unfit" register. You must visit the circuit medical centre to have yourself cleared medically and your machine must be re scrutineered before you practice or race again. Competitors who fail to follow this process will be excluded from the event. Please ask if you are unsure.
- Leaving the Circuit: Once you have seen the chequered flag at the end of all practice sessions and races, you will leave the circuit to the LEFT at turn 1 - Redgate corner. The pit lane is live and must be used during sessions or races to make changes or to retire from the track. Do not leave the circuit at turn 1 DURING sessions before the chequered flag. Use the pit lane.
- Motorised scooters and bikes including E scooters: Anything motorised including electric, is not permitted at this venue. While it is accepted the use of pedal/push bikes may be essential, to transit around the venue, we are afraid this does not include children playing on such bikes while the circuit is live.

PADDOCK RULES

- You must not hammer or insert pegs into the tarmac. Fuel must be stored in a suitable, fit for purpose container. Each team must be equipped with an approved, in-date fire extinguisher, random checking will take place. Report any spillages to the Race Office immediately.
- Tyres, batteries, contaminated fuel and oil containers are classed as hazardous waste. You MUST take them home with you. The club are charged per item left in the paddock.
- The riding of motorised bikes, or scooters including E Scooters anywhere at this venue is forbidden. If anyone is caught riding these, you and/or your team will be excluded from the event.
- Push bikes are permitted however, please do not allow children to use them in or around the paddock while the track is live.
- Children are welcome however, they must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- Generators: There is a 23:00 hrs curfew on running generators and all noise in the paddock. Please respect others. Competitors are responsible for the conduct of their family and team members.
- FIRE EXTINGUISHERS: Every working vehicle in the paddock and garage areas must have a working in date, 2kg (minimum)
 dry powder fire extinguisher as per the current ACU Standing Regulations Section 13 Item 3. Please also note the penalties for
 non-compliance.
