



NG Road Racing – Junior Supersport Championship Information & Conditions

1. INTRODUCTION

Junior Supersport Championship. There will be 3 Championship points scoring rounds at each NG Road Racing event, in partnership with Dan Cooper Motorsport

2. ELEGIBLE MACHINES:

NG Road Racing reserve the right to add to the list of eligible machines at any time. This will normally be in response to newly released models.

3. RESTRICTIONS

The following minimum weight limits apply to the machine only. Measurements will be taken during post race parc ferme (if instructed) with zero tolerance: To promote equality amongst the various manufacturers and concepts, NG Road Racing reserve the right to alter – either way – restrictions on eligible machines.

4. RIDER ELIGIBILITY

Riders must be a member of the NG Road Racing Club, hold a current ACU or SACU Road Race license and comply with ACU Standing Regulations for Road Race age restrictions. There is no maximum age limit, only those stated within ACU Road Race age restrictions.

5. SUSPENSION

Aftermarket / Race rear shock absorbers are permitted. Front fork internals may be upgraded including springs and damping however externally, forks and caps must be as homologated. A steering damper may be fitted but must not act as a steering lock.

6. NOISE

Exhaust systems may be changed but maximum noise levels must comply with current ACU noise levels. Machines may be tested any time during any event, including post race parc ferme.

7. TYRES

Any molded treaded tyres can be used. Wet / rain tyres are permitted. NG Road Racing reserve the right to introduce a control tyre rule at any time. Prior notice will be given of such changes amounting to a minimum of 2 championship rounds.

8. RACING NUMBERS

To simplify the identity of each manufacturer, the following number/background colours must be used:

Manufacturer	Number/Background
Yamaha	White on Blue
Honda	White on Red
Kawasaki Ninja	White on Green
KTM	White on Orange

9. MACHINE PREPARATION

Machines must comply with current ACU Standing regulations as laid down in the current ACU information library at www.acu.org.uk. It is the riders responsibility to ensure his/her machine is race worthy in accordance with these regulations. Engine, gearbox, frame, swinging arm and wheels must be as homologated. Quick shifters (strictly up-shift only) may be fitted. Down shift (blip systems) are not permitted. Fuel, oil and cooling systems must be as homologated, coolant will be replaced with water. The air box must be as homologated with no modifications. Electric starter, generator and alternator must be fitted and working as homologated at all times. Front and rear brake calipers and associated master cylinders must be as homologated. Reservoirs may be changed. A front brake lever protector must be fitted. Foot rest “rearsets” are permitted however, the original mounting points must be used. Aftermarket “race” bodywork must be used with all lights, indicators registration plate and mirrors removed. Handlebars may be replaced (retaining front brake master cylinder) however, the engine kill switch (red in colour) and starter button must be fitted and working. A working rear “rain” light must be fitted.

10. TITLE SPONSORS

Sponsor graphics and/or stickers must be displayed as/if directed.

The Championship Title Sponsor is Dan Cooper Motorsport

Trophies will be presented to 1st 2nd & 3rd place finishers in each race.

11. PARC FERME

Post race parc-ferme may be introduced at any time without warning, as directed by an official, where they will be held for a period of no more than 10 minutes, while ad hoc inspections will be carried out and measurements may be taken.
